

Year 7 catch up grant – Lansbury Bridge School 2019/2020

The literacy and numeracy catch-up premium gives schools additional funding to support year 7 pupils who did not achieve at least level 4 in reading and/or maths at the end of key stage 2 (KS2). Lansbury Bridge has 35 year 7 pupils. The school is allocated £16,000 for 2019/2020.
